Salutes can be bought from parents to their students or as a group of friends. Sizes range from 1/8 of a page to a full page and are available in color or black and white. Designs can be submitted if you wish, or the staff would be happy to design a salute for you.

To order a salute: (1) detach and fill out the form below, (2) gather up all pictures and text you'd like to appear in the salute space. (Please limit any quoted text to 4 lines or 10% of original material. No song lyrics will be printed.) (3) Mail these items to WRHS Journalism Department, Attention: Senior Salutes. If you have any specific instructions as to how you'd like the layout of the salute, include those in the envelope as well. (4) If you'd like the pictures returned to you, simply include a self-addressed and stamped envelope and the pictures will be returned to you as soon as the salute is complete.

Hurry, because space is limited. Salute deadline is Friday, December 4, 2009.
